## Corporate Membership Pricing 2023

Pricing effective June 1, 2023


#### Abstract

All memberships require one primary corporate member and a minimum of $\mathbf{2}$ additional (Golf or Social Sustaining) secondary members under the primary corporate membership with a maximum of 6 members per corporate membership. All memberships would be subject to verification by the membership committee to ensure that all corporate members are primarily employed by the same organization.


Pricing for primary members and secondary members that have not been members of FHCC for the prior 24 months with a 2-year agreement:

Primary member Golf:
\$395 monthly dues
$1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{yr}$. annual assessment capped at $\$ 400$
$2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{yr}$. assessment capped at $\$ 600$

Secondary members Golf:
$\$ 250$ monthly dues
$1^{\text {st }}$ yr. no annual assessment
$2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{yr}$. annual assessment capped at $\$ 400$
Primary Social Sustaining:
\$185 monthly dues
$1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{yr}$. annual assessment capped at $\$ 500$

Pricing for primary members and secondary members that are current members or have been members of FHCC in the prior 24 months:

Primary member Golf:
$\$ 645$ or current category rate at the time no assessment cap

Primary Social Sustaining:
\$185 or current category rate at the time no assessment cap

Secondary member Golf:
\$420 per month assessment capped at $\$ 600$ year

Secondary Social Sustaining:
$\$ 100$ per month assessment capped at $\$ 250$ year

Secondary dining only:
$\$ 80$ per month
assessment capped at $\$ 250$ year

Secondary dining only:
$\$ 50$ monthly dues
No annual assessment during agreement


All primary and secondary corporate members would be subject to the existing food and beverage minimum that can be charged per member or in total to the primary member. All memberships would convert to primary and secondary corporate membership rates listed above after agreement has expired. We would require at least one primary golf membership or social sustaining membership to participate in the corporate plan and at least 1 golf membership would need to be primary if any of the corporate members are golfing members.
